Red Trail

- West from kiosk: 1 mile
- Easy walk
- · Joint-trail use with bikes permitted
- The best trail for someone new to the park, offering views over the city center and the west hills

Green Trail

- East from kiosk: 1.7 miles
- Moderate walk with mountain views
- Biking is prohibited on the Green Trail, except for the paved roads.
- Excellent views of Mt. Hood from East Tabor Drive (weather permitting)
- · Circumnavigates the caldera amphitheater
- The best route for someone who prefers to walk primarily on paved surface since much of the trail is on the roadways

Blue Trail

- · West from kiosk: 3 miles
- · Moderately difficult walk with hills and steps
- · Joint-trail use with bikes permitted
- · Circumnavigates all three open-air reservoirs
- · The best route for walking on unpaved trails




